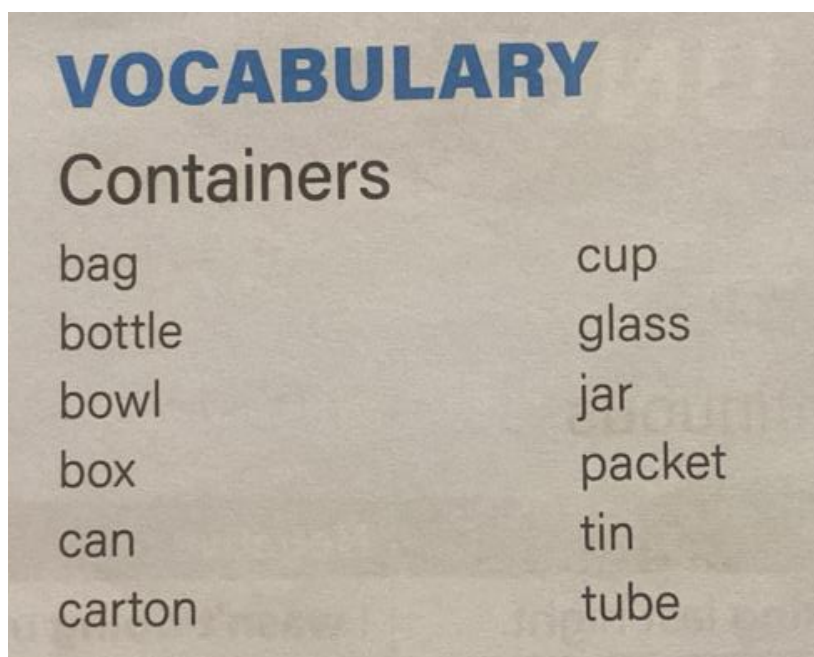

Quantifiers: <i>some, any, (how) much, many, a lot of</i>	
Countable nouns	Uncountable nouns
Affirmative	
I bought some bananas.	We ate some rice.
There were a lot of people.	There was a lot of traffic.
Negative	
We didn't play any games.	We haven't got any cheese.
I didn't eat many / a lot of peas.	There isn't much / a lot of fruit.
Questions	
Are there any oranges?	Have you got any money?
Has he got many / a lot of friends?	Do you do much / a lot of sport?
How many books have you got?	How much food is there?
Rules	
We use <i>some</i> and <i>a lot of</i> in affirmative sentences and we use <i>any</i> in negative sentences and questions.	
With countable nouns, we use <i>many</i> in negative sentences and questions. With uncountable nouns, we use <i>much</i> in negative sentences and questions.	
We can use <i>a lot of</i> in affirmative and negative sentences and in questions.

Comparatives and superlatives

Adjective		Comparative	Superlative
Short	small	smaller	the smallest
	wet	wetter	the wettest
	happy	happier	the happiest
Long	comfortable	more comfortable	the most comfortable
Irregular	good	better	the best
	bad	worse	the worst
	far	further	the furthest

Rules

We use the comparative + *than* to compare two things:

*I'm **taller than** my dad.*

We use *the* + superlative to compare more than two things:

*Delia is **the tallest** student in our class.*
