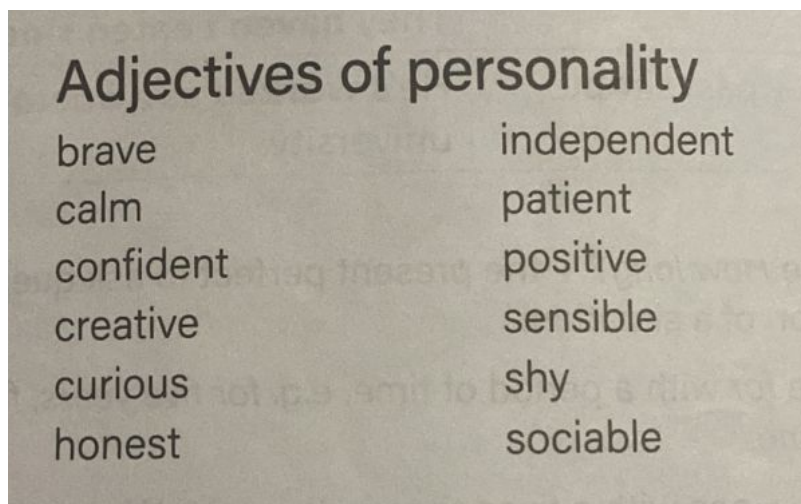


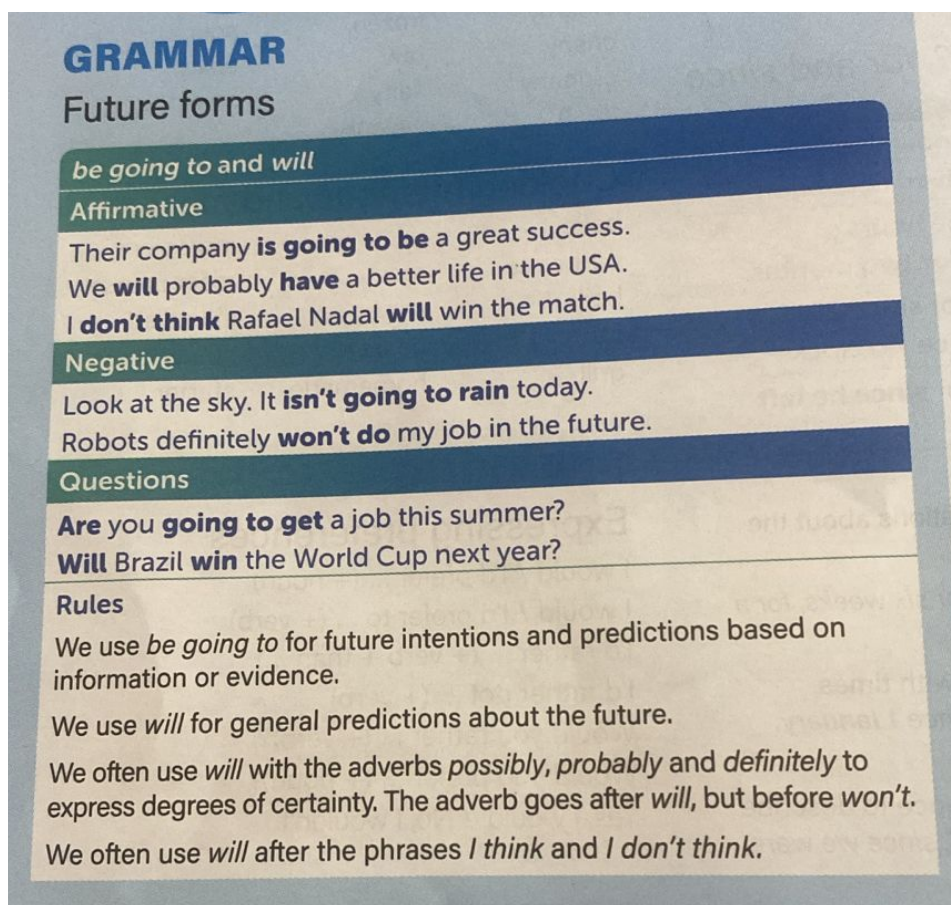

Used for real situations that can happen in the future.

- If you study, you'll pass the test.
- If I'm late, she'll be angry.
- If it rains, we'll stay home.
